CHALLENGES FACED IN 2021 AND 2022

- Main challenges stay in connection with lasting of COVID-19 pandemic.
- Critical law number of the ASM for treatment status epilepticus SE and other acute epilepsy conditions
- On 24 February 2022, a full-scale, terrible war broke out in many directions at once in Ukraine. The war has been accompanied by the destruction of civilian infrastructure. The health care system suffers from the damage and destruction of health care facilities, the medical supply system and logistics. In addition to the reduction of available resources in certain regions, the workload has increased due to the influx of victims. As a result, the provision of patients with antiseizure medication (ASM) has deteriorated significantly and in some regions has almost stopped. This caused an extremely large deficit in all regions of Ukraine for all drugs used. There was an urgency need to change the system for providing patients with epilepsy with antiepileptic drugs. The main problems that appeared in connection with the war and which required an extremely quick solutions are to assess the number of patients with epilepsy and the needs for ASM in Ukraine as a whole, to analyze the percentage of ASM taken in adult patients, in children, as well as the needs for drugs for emergency care.
