

## **Bursaries to support doctors from Africa developing training and skills capacity in Epilepsy**

Available through the Commission on African Affairs for 2017

*Competitive award up to \$5,000*

Applicants are invited to submit the following to the Committee of Education, CAA.

1. A copy of the nature of the project requiring funded support; curriculum, summary, outcomes (certificate, diploma, other qualifications), training or skills development area.
2. Short summary stating
  - Who the training / course supports (i.e. state who are trainees – e.g.GP, nurses, EEG technician, etc)
  - If it is a new course under “construction”, or an established course requiring updated capacity
  - How the training / course will improve services to the public health sectors.
3. A short biography of the applicant’s current place of work and affiliations.
4. A full budget of the resources needed to support the training program / course.

Applicants will be notified if they are successful by July 16<sup>th</sup> 2017.

*Examples of the type of support offered would be for software resources (access to on-line programs, electronic books or journals), text-books, support developing educational programs, on-site training establishing EEG service, visiting expert, and so on. This award is not for the development of service delivery such as staffing or EEG equipment.*
