#### **ILAE-EMR Chair's Overview**

It is my privilege to share with you this report of our activity for the year 2020. This year was marked by the COVID pandemic and all face-to-face activities or meeting were cancelled or held remotely. To continue our education activities during this year, we launched the ILAE-EMR monthly webinar series.

We are proud to share with you the results of these activities and especially our vision to improve their medical and social impact on our region and how to ensure their sustainability and development. We hope that during 2021 we can continue our education, research activities and hope that more chapters will join us.

### **ILAE-EMR** educational webinars on epilepsy:

This educational program was launched in August 2020. Because the countries of North Africa are French-speaking and those in other regions are English-speaking, we decided to have two courses per month, one in English and one in French, each with two speakers. The speakers were from the region and international, these webinars were an opportunity for the doctors of the region to have continuous training, to involve young people and above all to improve the visibility of the ILAE in the region. ## **EEG** interface

We are proud to introduce a new EEG tool to improve EEG reading for young EMR neurologists /physicians, by enlisting the help of international EEG experts within the EMR and from elsewhere with the objective of improving the interpretation of EEG recordings and, ultimately, the management of patients with epilepsy and other neurological disorders in our region. This easy-to-use website will remove geographic barriers between neurologists and EEG experts in the EMR. Information on how to use the new EEG tool, how to find EEG reference centers, together with the EEG expert web directory as well as epilepsy news and events, will be displayed in the EEG website (http://eeg.devsfax.org). The patient's clinical data and the EEG to be examined can be sent to the EEG expert in a secure manner.
