

SPECIFICATIONS FOR POSTERS

- 1) The size of the poster should not exceed **94 cm wide and 2.34m high** in vertical format.
- 2) We suggest that you structure your poster into the following sections:
 - Title, authors, and contact information (at the top of the poster)
 - Objective
 - Methodology
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- 3) Do not overload the poster with too much text: use graphics and images. Do not enter superfluous elements.
- 4) The poster must correspond to the abstract sent and accepted by the Scientific Committee.
- 5) The poster must be written in Spanish, Portuguese or English
- 6) The color scheme contributes to the good design of a poster. Choose neutral or gray tones for the background: they make it easy to read and enhance color photos.
- 7) The poster must be printed on paper or light cardboard. Do not use thick cardboard: it is too heavy and will tend to detach from the support.
- 8) Each poster will be assigned a support number, and each support will be clearly marked with its corresponding number.
- 9) The posters will be fixed to the support using double-sided adhesive tape (provided by the Congress)
- 10) Bring your delegate ID when you go to assemble your poster: it will ensure access to the exhibition area. We recommend that you also bring a printed copy of the e-mail you received notifying you of the acceptance of your abstract.

Sessions and schedules

The poster exhibition will be open at Antioquia 1, from 08:00 am to 18:00 pm. Each poster will be on display for one day. The poster tours will take place on Sunday 2 and Monday 3 October, from 14:00 – 15:00 hours. The date of the poster presentation will be communicated to each author in advance of the congress by email.

The author shall:

- · Assemble your poster between 08:00 and 10:00 in the morning of the day indicated for your presentation
- Disassemble your poster between 17:00 and 18:00 in the afternoon of the day indicated for presentation
- Be present next to your poster during the poster session. Authors should be present to answer questions from delegates and the poster session coordinator.
