

## POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

---

- 1) The size of the poster must not exceed **94 cm wide and 2.34m high** in portrait format.
- 2) We suggest that you structure your poster in the following sections:
  - Title, authors, and contact information (at the top across the width of the poster)
  - Objective
  - Methodology
  - Results
  - Conclusion
- 3) Don't overload the poster with too much text: use graphics and images. Do not introduce superfluous elements.
- 4) The poster must correspond to the abstract sent and accepted by the Scientific Committee.
- 5) The poster must be written in Spanish, Portuguese or English
- 6) The color scheme contributes to a good poster design. Choose neutral or gray tones for the background – they make it easier to read and enhance color photos.
- 7) The poster must be printed on paper or light cardstock. Do not use thick cardboard: it is too heavy and will tend to come off the backing.
- 8) Each poster will be assigned a support number, and each support will be clearly marked with its corresponding number.
- 9) Posters will be attached to the stand using double-sided adhesive tape (provided by the Congress)
- 10) Bring your delegate ID with you when you come to put up your poster – it will ensure you access to the exhibition area. We recommend that you also bring a printed copy of the e-mail you received notifying you of the acceptance of your abstract.

### Sessions & Schedules

The poster exhibition will be open at ANACAONA C from 08:00 am to 18:00 pm. Each poster will be on display for one day. The poster tours will take place on Sunday 16 and Monday 17 June from 2:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. The date of the poster presentation will be communicated to each author in advance of the congress by email.

The author must:

- Assemble your poster between 08:00 and 10:00 in the morning of the day indicated for its presentation
- Dismantle your poster between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on the day indicated for presentation
- Be present with your poster during the poster session. Authors should be present to answer questions from delegates and the poster session coordinator.
