#### **Course Objectives**

- Define: seizure, epilepsy, epilepsy syndrome and be able to provide a simple classification of epilepsy
- Describe the different seizure types eg absence, myoclonic, tonic clonic, tonic, atonic, focal motor and focal sensory
- Give differential diagnosis for seizures, and how to distinguish epilepsy from syncope (simple faints, reflex anoxic seizure, breath holding) and inattention (day-dreaming, pre-occupation)
- Manage the first seizure event (not status epilepticus management)
- Appreciate the contribution made by EEG and neuro-imaging
- Describe the principles of treatment, the indication for anti-convulsants and the well-known side effects of these drugs
- Offer practical advice for parents and children with epilepsy

#### **Achievements**

- We achieved 102% sign up and 101% training attendance and completion.
- The communication and engagement with the participants in the WhatsApp groups helped in coordination and time keeping.

- In addition to the grant from ILAE the course director secured additional funds to facilitate the training; we received funds from Moi Teaching and Referral Hospital, SunPharma EA Ltd and Neuro-EEG study MTRH.

### **Challenges**

- The team needed more time to fund raise for the training to enable applicants pay a subsidized amount.
- Most participants are used to attend sponsored trainings therefore it was a bit challenging to get participants who are willing to pay for themselves the full course amount; however, the grant from ILAE and other partners subsidized the training fees for participants by 60%.

### **Conclusion and Recommendations**

- There was high demand for the course in Eldoret, majority of the participants came from similar institutions. A future training should consider widening the number of participants from other public and private institutions in the region.

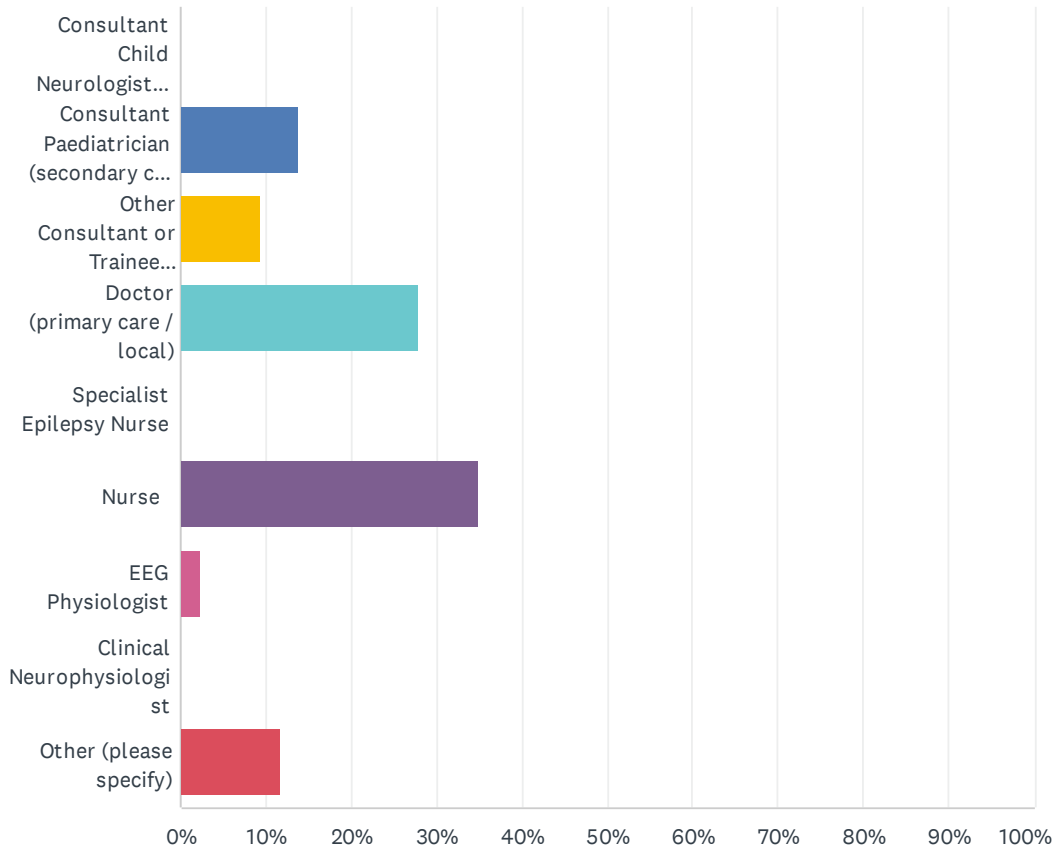

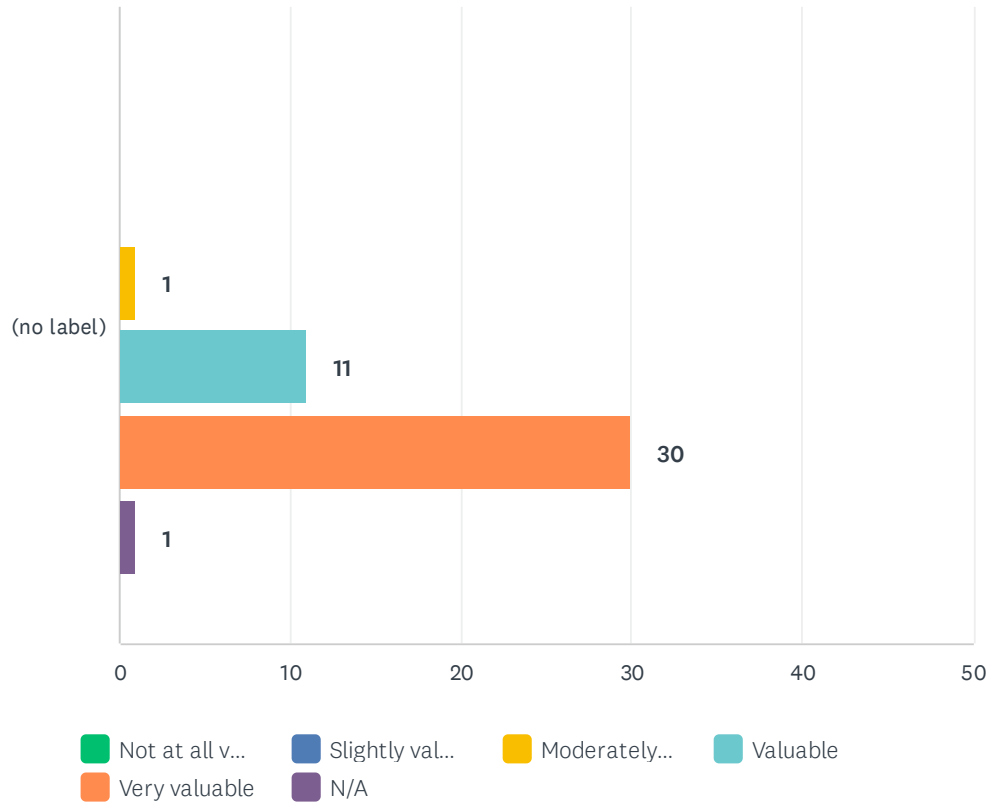

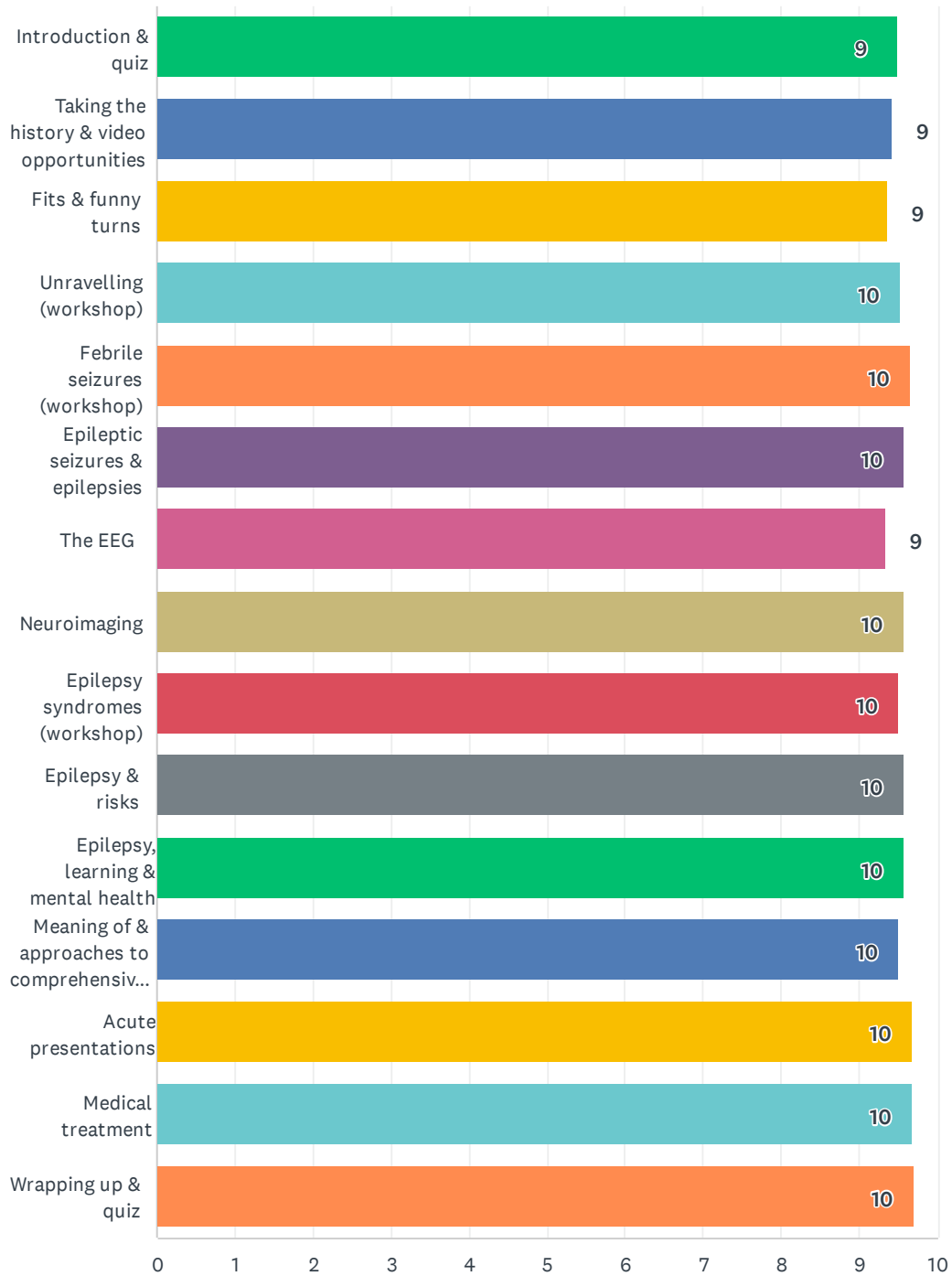

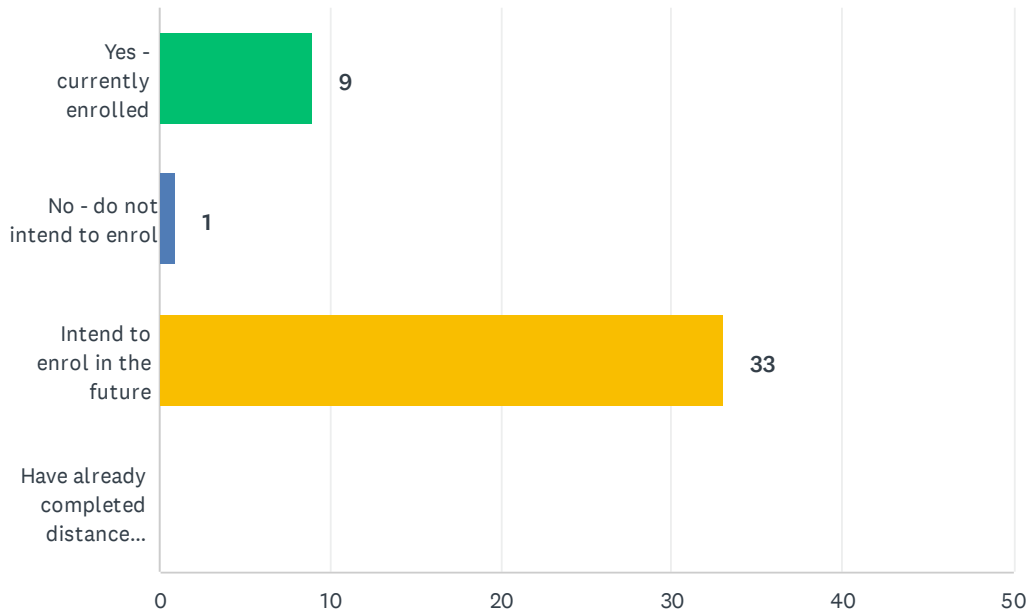

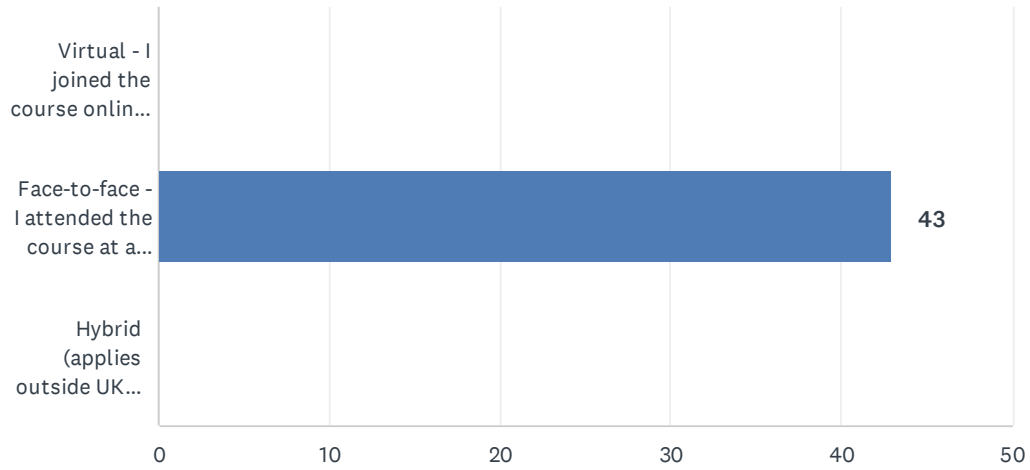

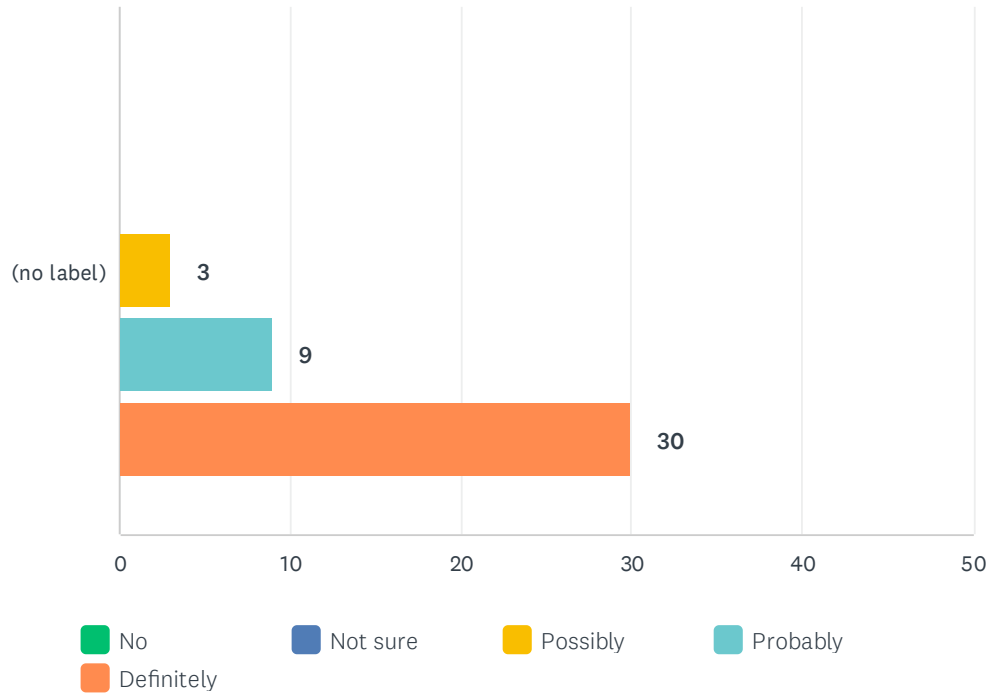

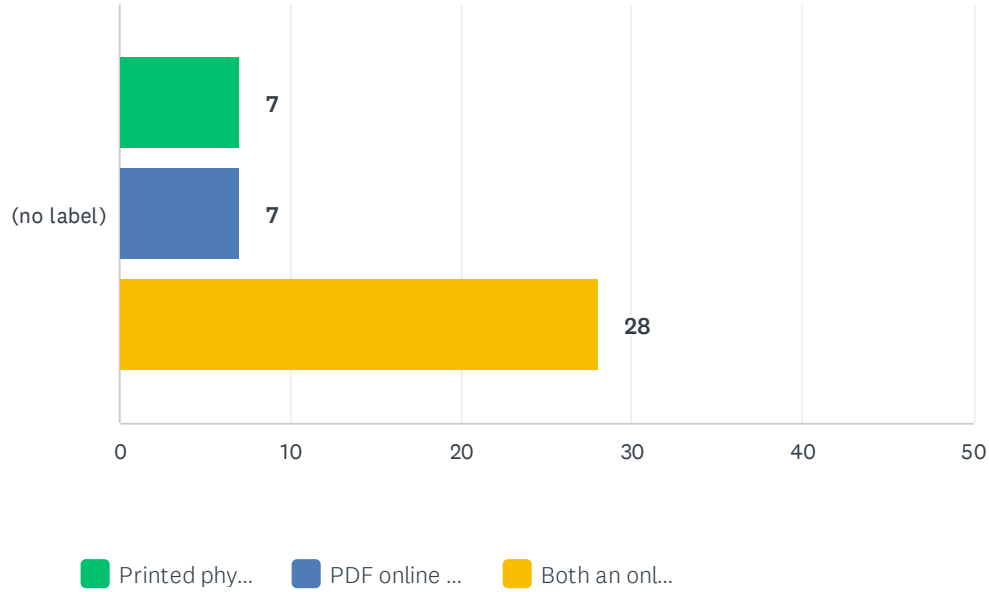
