

## Distance learning course on Genetics of epilepsy (III.)

Beginning in autumn 2006 (and lasting for about 8 months) the European Epilepsy Academy offers for the third time a distance education course on "Genetics of epilepsy".

Successful participation in the course awards 65 Credit Points for the curriculum of the **European Certification in Epileptology for Medical Doctors** for the elective "Genetics of Epilepsy".

An **introductory meeting** will take place during the 7<sup>th</sup> European Congress on Epileptology in Helsinki, Finland. However, attending this kick-off meeting is not mandatory for course participation.
