The KEC 2016 is an international meeting and exhibition for those who share the common scientific and clinical interests of epilepsy, clinical neurophysiology and the associated social issues. The meeting offers high-quality educational content across diverse work settings, professional roles and experience levels. There are several categories of comprehensive program:

Plenary & Presidential Symposium - Provide the major impact on the activities at KEC 2016. Topics range from more complex, cutting-edge topics combining basic sciences to practical approaches on clinical epileptology.

Special Interest Groups (SIGs) - Offer a less formal opportunity for attendees with similar interests to explore specific topics [Basic Neuroscience (SIG 1) & Stereotaxic EEG and Related Epilepsy Surgical Approaches (SIG 2)]. Although the sizes of SIG sessions vary, all lend themselves to active participation and dialogue.

Teaching Sessions - Review of the science underlying the topics, reviews of essential clinical practice and discussion of the associated clinical implications using a mixture of educational lectures, clinical vignettes and case presentations. **Parallel & Satellite symposiums** - Cover the major educational activities at the KEC 2016. Topics range from clinically oriented presentations reviewing common issues in epilepsy to more complex topics combining basic sciences and clinical neurology and neurosurgery.



Seoul has been the capital of Korea for about 600 years. Seoul has developed into a bustling metropolis, acting as the political, economic, social, and cultural hub of the nation.
