



Dr. Wei-Ping Liao graduated from Hunan Medical College in 1983. He began his career in epilepsy in 1988, when he received trainings in Japan National Epilepsy Center. He is now a vice president of China Association Against Epilepsy and an editorial board member of *Epilepsia*. He devoted himself greatly to the international activities on epilepsy. As a member of Asian Epilepsy Academy, he has organized and contributed to more than 20 epilepsy workshops and the latest five Asian Oceanian Epilepsy Conferences.

Dr. Liao is the director of the Institute of Neuroscience at Guangzhou Medical University. He headed this institute to become a Key Laboratory of Neurogenetics and Channelopathies in China. Among many contributions that emerged recently are his seminal contributions on the regulatory mechanism of sodium channel gene expression and the relationship between seizure aggravation and channel dysfunction, which are expected to be valuable for basic researches and management of epilepsy.
