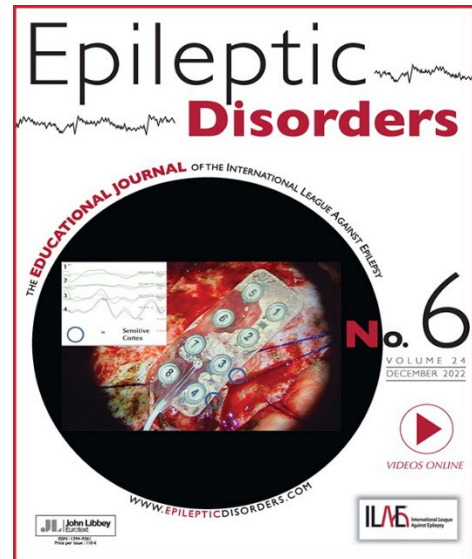


Epileptic Disorders 2022 Annual Report

ACTIVITIES

- One-hundred-nineteen papers were published in the six issues last year – including educational review papers (seminars in epileptology) and papers from ILAE task forces. An educational channel was started on YouTube and the visibility of the journal on various social media platforms increased significantly. In total 328 manuscripts were submitted and evaluated.
- The contract with the publisher, John Libbey Eurotext expired at the end of 2022. ILAE accepted the offer from Wiley, which will be the new publisher starting January 2023.



HIGHLIGHTS

- The average time from submission to first decision markedly decreased: 2 days for editorial decision, 30 days for peer reviewed manuscripts
- There was a significant increase in the journal circulation - the number of downloads increased more than 200%
- The impact factor increased from 1.89 to 2.33.
