Applications and Registration

Registration is required in advance and spaces will be limited to 45 participants. Applications to attend the course must be received by 31 December 2023. Early applications are encouraged to secure your place and avoid disappointment.

Applications should include a brief covering letter with a description of your current clinical practice and experience in the field of neuropsychology and/or epilepsy, accompanied by a short CV (no more than 3 pages).

Full payment is not required with the application, but if your application is successful, a deposit of \$500 will be required to secure your place. Deposits will be refunded if the course does not take place. However if you are unable to attend due to local travel restrictions at the time of the conference, we will be unable to refund course fees. You may wish to consider insurance to cover this eventuality.

Registration fee: 1,750 Euros



The registration fee covers the cost of all teaching, course materials, five nights all inclusive, full board accommodation and transfers to and from the venue from the air and rail travel hubs close to the venue (Lyon International Airport, Train station).
