

## Serbian League Against Epilepsy 2021-2022 Report

### ACTIVITIES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

In 2021 and 2022, the Serbian League Against Epilepsy continued with traditional activities despite ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Two National Schools of Epilepsy each gathering more than 100 League members and professionals interested in epileptology were held in that period. 22nd School was dedicated to emergency situations in epileptology while the focus of 23rd School was on pharmacological treatment of epilepsy. In April 2022, the League also organized Epilepsy and Pregnancy Symposium, the first mutual meeting of neurologists and gynecologists in Serbia. World Epilepsy Days in 2021 and 2022 were marked by several workshops and forums oriented towards education of common folk about matters of stigma in epilepsy.

### CHALLENGES FACED IN 2021 AND 2022

Main challenge in past two years represented in the form of COVID-19 pandemic was overcome by the enthusiastic approach of League members to organize different activity despite challenging epidemiological situation. All meeting were held with the respect of all recommended measures against spreading of SARS-CoV2 virus.

### FUTURE PLANS FOR 2023

The plan of Serbian League in 2023 will be the organization of 11th Migratory Course in Belgrade and 24th National School of Epilepsy.
