

INTERNATIONAL LEAGUE AGAINST EPILEPSY
COMMISSION ON EASTERN MEDITERRANEAN AFFAIRS

Announcement

The International League Against Epilepsy's (ILAE) Commission on Eastern Mediterranean Affairs (CEMA) is pleased to announce the availability of fellowships for young epileptologist interested to engage in further training in epilepsy, including internships in epilepsy monitoring units. The timing and duration of fellowships will be determined later in collaboration between the candidate and the accepting center. However, a minimum of two months is required. The amount of support to be used for accommodation and travel cannot exceed 3000 US dollars for the entire fellowship.

Selection of candidates will be made by CEMA executive board members, and the number of fellowships will depend on availability of funds. To apply, applicants should submit:

- Copy of a recent CV and any supporting document(s) as considered appropriate;
- Documentation that the applicant has completed at least 6 months of service in a high volume EEG/epilepsy lab/clinic;
- A letter from head of department of the applicant's Institution indicating how the Institution intends to utilize the expertise acquired by the applicant during the fellowship;
- Letter of acceptance from a level 3 or 4 care center where training will occur. In the absence of such letter, CEMA may take responsibility for identifying a center suitable for the candidate expectations and needs;
- The application should specify the proposed duration of fellowship and the amount of financial support required.
