

Report on ASEPA Epilepsy Training Course

The Asian Epilepsy Academy (ASEPA), in collaboration with the Taiwan Epilepsy Society and the Children's Epilepsy Association of Taiwan, held an epilepsy training course in Taipei on November 15 and 16, 2025, providing comprehensive learning and practical training for neurologists and pediatric neurologists. The two-day course conducts in-depth symptomatology and EEG teaching through real-case discussions to popularize and deepen basic and clinical knowledge related to epilepsy, delivered in face-to-face physical training camps.

We invited Professor Chong Wong, an internationally renowned neurologist and epilepsy expert from Australia, as well as 12 senior and renowned advanced doctors in Taiwan, to serve as lecturers and mentors. These instructors have extensive clinical experience and academic achievements, and more than 20 participants experienced a memorable learning through lean group interactive discussions.
