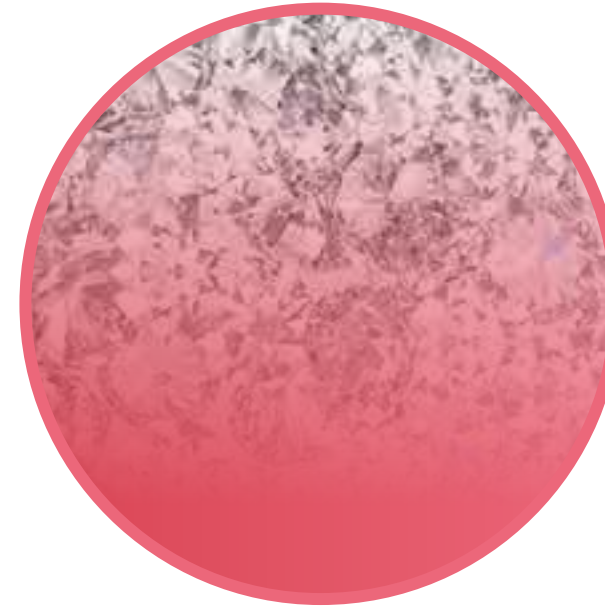

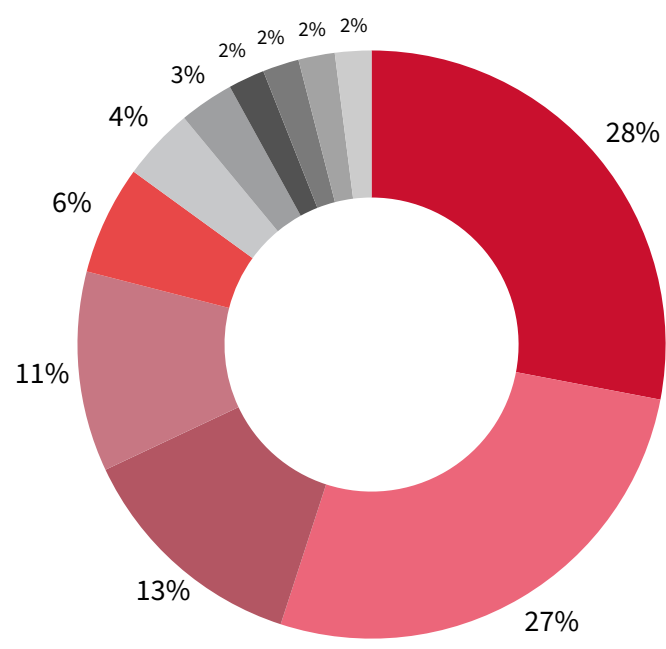
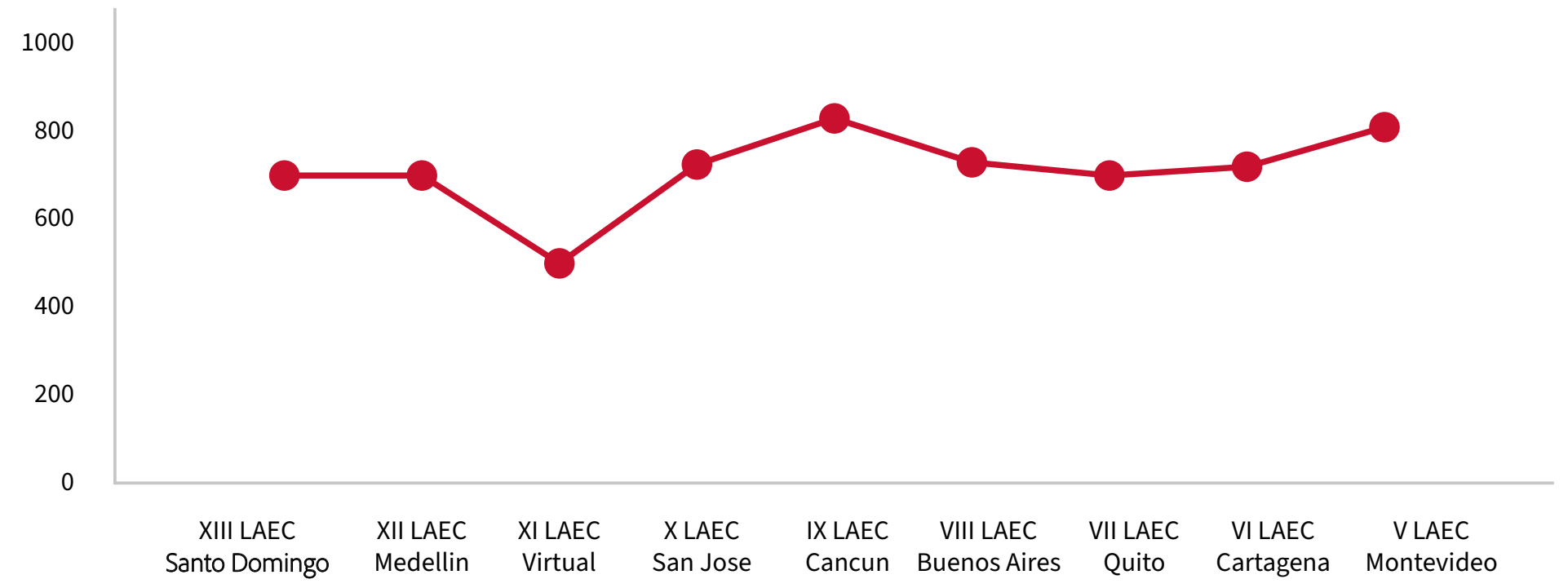


LAEC ATTENDANCE

Confirmation

Once sponsorship is confirmed, an invoice will be issued for the full amount and, a sponsorship agreement will be sent to the sponsor for signature. For show-only bookings, the show-on booking form constitutes the agreement; no additional arrangement will be required. Please note that until the Organizer has received the payments and the sponsorship agreement signed, the articles will be considered provisionally reserved.

Terms and Conditions

Full terms and conditions of the sponsorship will be outlined in the sponsorship agreement or linked in the exhibition booking form. If a copy of the general terms and conditions is required in advance, please contact the Organizer.

Payment Schedule

Payment will be made according to the following schedule:

- 50% of the total sponsorship upon signing the agreement or submission of the exhibition booking form
- Remaining 50% by 23 February 2026

Payment Deadlines

Please note that the full cost of any sponsorship or exhibition booked on or after 09 February 2026 must be paid in full immediately to secure the items.

If full payment has not been received by 02 March 2026, the Congress Organizer reserves the right to cancel the booking, and the cancellation will be subject to the official cancellation policy.

Cancellation Policy

Notification of cancellation of all or part of sponsorship reservation must be sent to the Congress Organizer in writing. Refunds will be settled within two months of the congress in order to facilitate necessary organizational and logistical procedures. The cancellation of registration fees is as follows:

EXHIBITION RULES

Force Majeure

The Organizer reserves the right to modify dates, time schedules, floor plans and programmes in case of necessity. In case of forcible cancellation of the Congress, the moneys paid by exhibitors shall be reimbursed, less proportional deduction of expenses incurred. Under no circumstances shall exhibitors be indemnified.

Exhibition Stands

In the case where there is a breach of the regulations on building and decoration of stands and/or a breach of technical nature, the Organizer and/ or the Congress venue is/are entitled to carry out the necessary procedure to regularise it, which may involve closing the stand. The costs resulting from this corrective action will be charged to the exhibitor. The specified set up and dismantling dates and times must be adhered to.

Maximum Build Height

The maximum build height for free-build exhibition stands is 2.45

Suspended Structures

Suspended structures will not be possible in the venue.

Shell Scheme Exhibition Booths

Each shell scheme exhibition booth includes: back and separation walls, fascia panel with company name, standard furniture, stand preparation, construction and dismantling

Exhibited Products

Presentation and distribution of products that can harm other exhibitors or visitors, or that can damage the floor and/or existing constructions, is prohibited. Samples of medicine may not be exhibited or distributed. There may be no reference to price on products on display (except books/ journals).

Stand & Marketing Activities

Marketing of any product and/or service in any part of the exhibition area or meeting rooms by non-exhibiting companies is not permitted. Personnel of exhibiting companies must confine their activities to the exhibition stand. Distribution of literature, promotional activities, etc. will not be permitted in the aisles or outside the exhibition area.

Subletting

Subletting of exhibition space is not permitted.

Audio and/or Visual Disturbance

Audiovisual and other devices will be permitted only in those locations and in such intensity as, in the opinion of the Organizer, they do not interfere with the activities of neighbouring exhibitors. Sound equipment must be regulated and directed into the booth, so that it does not disturb neighbouring exhibitors. The Organizer reserves the right to demand a reduction in the intensity of, or complete cessation of, stand noise that it judges to be excessive or a disturbance to others.

Publicity & Advertising

All exhibitors must be the producers, importers or representatives of the goods and/or services displayed on their stands. Advertising material and signs may not be distributed or displayed outside the exhibition stand. Advertising that may harm or inconvenience other exhibitors or visitors is strictly forbidden.

Insurance

Each exhibitor is responsible for its own products, displays and stand, and should take out insurance for the duration of the Congress, transport and storage. The Organizer and the Congress venue shall not accept responsibility for loss of, or damage to, the exhibit or property of an exhibitor or any other person, brought about by fire, theft, or any other cause whatsoever.
